1. *Aimery Pinot Noir, Vin de Pays d'oc 2008 (France) - A peppery bouquet showing a hint of red berries.* £3.50 £4.60 £12.95
2. *Post Tree Shiraz Cinsault 2009 (South Africa) - This exciting blend of Shiraz & Cinsault introduces an array of ripe berries, and follows through in a juicy well structured palate with a smooth finish.* £3.50 £4.60 £12.95
3. *Beaujolais Villages AC, Latour 2008 (France) - A richly flavoured wine from the Gamay grape, softly tannic with a smooth finish.* £16.75

4. *Sacred Hill Shiraz Cabernet 2008 (Australia) - Soft, spicy Shiraz blended with rich, full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon.* £4.00 £5.20 £14.95
5. *La Emperatriz Tempranillo, DOC Rioja 2008 (Spain) - Aromas of ripe red fruit strawberry, plum with a background of licorice and vanilla. A soft and persistent wine on the palate.* £4.50 £5.70 £16.75
6. *Sacred Hill Cabernet Merlot 2008 (Australia) - This lightly wooded blend displays blackberry, plum and cinnamon aromas with a hint of vanilla.* £4.00 £5.20 £14.95
7. *Purisma Reserva Merlot, Maule Valley 2007 (Chile) - This wine displays rich plum, chocolate and black berry flavours.* £15.50
8. *Cristobel 1492 Malbec, Mendoza 2008 (Argentina) - A classic, well balanced wine with a perfect combination of ripe red fruits and spices.* £16.75
9. *Carlos Serres Crianza, DOC Rioja 2005 (Spain) - A soft, classic Rioja with a fragrant bouquet of cedar wood and ripe fruit.* £16.75
10. *DouRosa Tinto Quinta de la Rosa DOC Douro 2008 (Portugal) - The DouRosa red is expressive and seductive on the nose. It is reasonably full bodied with well developed fruit flavours giving the wine dimension and character.* £16.95
11. *Old Coach Road Pinot Noir, Nelson 2008 (New Zealand) - Rich cherry flavours with a warm finish.* £20.75
12. *Ch Vieux Clos, Grand Cru, Saint Emilion 2005 (France) - A powerful, yet subtle wine with a very alluring bouquet.* £28.00

Serious reds, full and fruity

13. *Foot of Africa Pinotage, Stellenbosch 2007 (South Africa) - Ample, rounded, spicy fruit with a hint of sweetness.* £18.25
14. *Wente Zinfandel, San Francisco Bay 2004 (California) - Bursting with spicy aromas and flavours of raspberries and black pepper.* £18.50
15. *Doolhof Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 (South Africa) - A true classic Cabernet, ripe full bodied and velvety, bursting with dark fruits, cedar tones and mellow tannins* £19.50
16. *Marques de Riscal Reserva, DOC Rioja 2005 (Spain) - A distinctive Rioja, with a fruity bouquet and a lingering finish.* £25.00
17. *Barolo DOCG, Antario 2005 (Italy) - A full flavoured, powerful wine; having ample fruit and great depth.* £29.50
18. *Chateaufneuf du Pape AC, Domaine Jean Deydier 2004 (France) - Slightly spicy, light in colour but deep in flavour, succulent and mellow.* £33.50
